## **THE ORGANISATION, ECONOMICS AND POLICY OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH**

LEI & BRICK with financial support from the Collegio Carlo Alberto are organising their annual workshop on “The Organisation, Economics and Policy of Scientific Research” on **11-12 May, 2015** at Collegio Carlo Alberto in Moncalieri (Torino, Italy).

The aim of the workshop is to bring together a small group of scholars interested in the analysis of the production and diffusion of scientific research from an economics, historical, organizational, and policy perspective.

### **Call for papers**

As in previous years, we aim to attract contributions from both **junior and senior scholars**; a minimum number of slots are reserved for junior researchers (PhD students or postdoc scholars who obtained their PhD in 2012 or later).

Up to 20 papers will be selected from open submissions on the basis of peer review.

The workshop aims at including papers from various streams of research developed in recent years in and around the area of public and private scientific research. Contributions are invited on (but not limited to) one or more of the following topics:

- Evaluation and peer review in science**
- Organisation of research activities**
- Public and private funding of academic research**
- Role of gender and family in scientific research**
- Science research networks and collaboration**
- Scientific careers & mobility**
- Scientific knowledge production**
- Teaching and research interaction**

1<sup>st</sup> May 2015. Deadline for submission of final papers
